INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Place the motorcycle on a suitable stand to safely support it while you perform the installation.
- 2. Remove stock drive pulley cover bracket and drive pulley cover per Yamaha service manual procedures. Flatten lock tab on stock pulley nut. Loosen pulley nut.

NOTE: When loosening the drive pulley nut, press down on the brake pedal to prevent the pulley from turning.

- 3. Loosen the rear axle and slide rear wheel forward to allow enough slack in the belt for easier pulley removal. Remove stock drive pulley.
- 4. Install new pulley with flanged side out, along with new lock-tab washer (supplied) and stock pulley nut. The stock pulley nut is 2-sided. One side is flat. Make sure the flat side is flush with the pulley surface before tightening. Tighten pulley nut to 61 ft-lbs.
- 5. Adjust drive belt and tighten rear axle per Yamaha service manual procedures.
- 6. Reinstall stock drive pulley cover and drive pulley cover bracket per Yamaha service manual procedures.

IMPORTANT: Be sure to re-check the pulley nut torque after 100 miles.
